AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, the definition of "eligible individual" in Subsection A of Section 123-46.5, Tax credit for elderly individuals and veterans, of Article II, Real Property Tax Credits, of Chapter 123, Finance and Taxation, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to establish a property tax credit for the surviving spouses of certain elderly veterans; and generally relating to real property tax credits.

1 Section 1. Be It Enacted By The County Council of Harford County, Maryland that the definition
2 of “eligible individual” in Subsection A of Section 123-46.5, Tax credit for elderly individuals and
3 veterans, of Article II, Real Property Tax Credits, of Chapter 123, Finance and Taxation, of the
4 Harford County Code, as amended, be, and it is hereby, repealed and reenacted, with amendments, all
5 to read as follows:

6 **Chapter 123. Finance and Taxation**

7 **Article II. Real Property Tax Credits**

8 **§ 123-46.5. Tax credit for elderly individuals and veterans.**

9 A. For purposes of this section, the following terms have the meanings indicated:

10 **ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUAL –**

11 (1) An individual who is at least 65 years old and has lived in the same dwelling for at least
12 the [preceeding] PRECEDING 40 years; [or]


13 (2) An individual who is at least 65 years old and is a retired member of the uniformed
14 services of the United States as defined in 10 U.S.C. § 101, the military reserves or the
15 National Guard[.]; OR

16 (3) A SURVIVING SPOUSE, WHO HAS NOT REMARRIED, OF AN INDIVIDUAL
17 DESCRIBED IN ITEM (2) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

18 Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted that this Act shall take effect 60 calendar days from the date
19 it becomes law.
